

<p>COURSE TITLE</p>	<p align="center">DANGEROUS GOODS DRIVERS (Legal Notice 211.2003 Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road)</p>
<p>COURSE AIM</p>	<p>Malta has adopted the European Agreement Concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (better known and referred to as the ADR) for movement within its national territory. The ADR was prepared under the auspices of the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe and provides very comprehensive information on the measures that are necessary in order to accomplish the objectives of the agreement. Vehicles registered in non-EU member countries are allowed to perform international transport within the territories of EU member states if they comply with ADR.</p> <p>The European Agreement specifies which dangerous goods are barred from international carriage and lists those that are authorised. It also contains all the necessary information required by participants that enables them to take the appropriate measures that will ensure the safest possible movement.</p> <p>SL 65.22 Motor Vehicles (Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road) Regulations (Legal Notice 211.2003) makes it illegal for vehicles carrying dangerous goods to operate unless the driver is in possession of a vocational training certificate covering the appropriate goods of substance. Dangerous Goods (DG) vocational training is mandatory under Council Directive 94/55/EC. Enforcement officers are undergoing training that will enable them to carry out ADR Roadside Checks on vehicles and drivers.</p> <p>The Employment and Training Corporation is organising a set of such courses in Maltese leading to ADR Certification. The Malta Transport Authority will issue an ADR Certificate to participants following successful completion of a written (multi-choice) examination during the course. The courses to be organised by ETC are:</p> <p><u>Course A:</u></p> <p>For drivers collecting from ports containers/trailers/loose cargo that might contain dangerous goods – ‘burdnar’.</p> <p><u>Course B:</u></p> <p>For drivers carrying flammable liquids and gases e.g. tanker/dowser drivers, fuel carriers, gas cylinders.</p>
