

COURSE TITLE	VRT TESTERS – CLASS III
COURSE AIM	The aim of this course is to enable the trainee to acquire a licence to carry out the mandatory tests on motor vehicles and their trailers in Class III the Gross Vehicle Weight of which starts from 3500kg in an Authorised Vehicle Testing Station to the limits as published in the main VRT Legal Notice 126/1998 and it's subsequent amendments.

VENUE	At the ETC Training Complex in Hal Far.
ELIGIBILITY	All persons aged 16 years and over and who are in possession of Motor Vehicle City & Guilds Mechanics Certificate and a valid driving licence OR five years unimpaired practical experience in Motor Vehicles repairs and a valid driving licence
FEE	The training course is provided Free of Charge. There is a fee for the issuing of the VRT Testers Licence given to successful candidates and issued directly by the Malta



	Transport Authority.
CERTIFICATION	On completion of the course, an exam paper is taken and if a pass is obtained a VRT Testers Licence is issued by the Malta Transport Authority.
